**CASE MANAGEMENT**

HIV/AIDS case managers support clients by assessing needs and coordinating services. Access to case management services is available throughout Area 1. **DISEASE MANAGEMENT**

**Positive Healthcare** is a disease management program available to all Medipass and PAC clients in Florida. Clients are assigned a personal RN Care Manager to provide education, intervention and support in managing their HIV disease and associated conditions. Nurses coordinate with all local AIDS service agencies, Primary Care Providers, Medical Specialists and Social Work Agencies. **EDUCATION**

Area 1 Community-Based Organizations and Case Managers have information for clients about HIV/AIDS and related topics including: living with HIV/AIDS, nutrition and food safety, medications, and more. The **Area 1 HIV/AIDS Program** at the **Escambia County Health Department** stocks brochures and booklets for clients living with HIV/AIDS. They can also recommend internet resources for trusted and current information.

**FLORIDA AIDS DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Clients may apply for assistance in obtaining medicines used in the treatment of HIV disease and AIDS. Eligibility determination and enrollment can be obtained through:

Compassionate assistance programs are available for many drugs used in the treatment of HIV disease and AIDS. These programs are accessed when a client is otherwise ineligible for any other source of assistance. Patients with Medicaid/Medicare or private insurance that covers drugs are not usually eligible for these programs. Contact a case manager, ADAP nurse or ask your doctor for more information.

**HIV TESTING**

Confidential and anonymous HIV antibody testing is available at all **County Health Departments**. Test results usually return in two weeks. **HOME HEALTH CARE**

**Project AIDS Care (PAC)** is a medicaid program which offers services in the home to persons with AIDS who are at risk for hospitalization or institutional care. **HOUSING ASSISTANCE**

**INFORMATION/REFERRAL**

**The Florida Area 1 HIV/AIDS Program Office** in **Pensacola** provides administrative, education/prevention and disease surveillance services. The office also serves as a central information and referral source with HIV counselors on staff. Program staff also offer free accredited courses in HIV/AIDS education. Call 595.6345.

**INSURANCE CONTINUATION**

The **AIDS Insurance Continuation Program (AICP)** helps with payment of health and dental insurance premiums for those eligible individuals already covered. For information, contact a case manager at **OASIS 314.0950** in Ft Walton.

**MEDICAL CARE**

The **HIV Care Center, Inc.** at the **Center for Prevention and Treatment of Infections** in Pensacola provides HIV/AIDS specialty care funded by Ryan White Part B. Eligibility/fees are based on income with most unemployed or disabled clients receiving care for no fee. Call 476.3131 in Pensacola.

**Ryan White Part C Early Intervention Services** is a program which offers an outpatient system of coordinated care to persons living with HIV/AIDS in Okaloosa, Walton and surrounding counties. The program offers outpatient primary medical care with appropriate referrals to specialty care and other needed services. Referral from a Ryan White case manager is required. Call 833.9240 ext. 2153 for more information.

HIV/AIDS Surveillance receives and processes confidential HIV/AIDS case reports (required of physicians/laboratories by Florida law), and provides reporting forms and assistance. **Children's Medical Services (CMS) 484.5040** offers free confidential HIV Counseling and Testing Services for children aged 12 years and younger. Testing is conducted by appointment. CMS also offers a pediatric HIV sub-specialty clinic held four times per month in Pensacola for children (from birth to 21 yrs) exposed to or infected with HIV. **The Seton Center of Sacred Heart Hospital 416-2400** offers Obstetrical and Gynecological services for women living with HIV/AIDS. Women may be referred by their physicians or may access these services themselves. Educational and support services are also offered.
